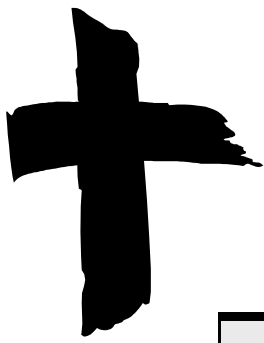

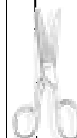

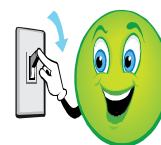


## Card Making
