Bible Study

Read Galatians 6:7 - 16.

1. Do you know people who have truly reaped what they have sown? For bad? For good?
2. Do you weary of doing good? What is the reason for your answer?
3. What harvest do you expect to reap at the proper time?

4. St. Paul obviously thought this next bit so important that he was writing the letter with his own hand. What exactly were the “Judaisers” trying to get the Christians to do? Why were they?

5. In what way were the Judaisers themselves failing to observe the law?

6. What exactly is this “new creation” and how did it come about?

7. What should our response be as part of this “new creation”?

Read Luke 10:1 - 12

8. We also have been “empowered” by Jesus through the sending of His Holy Spirit. In the light of this passage how should we be responding?
